



# Entering Switzerland during Covid-19

## 1. You travelled to a country with an an increased risk of infection:



Since the 6th of July 2020, people who have spent time in a country or area with an increased risk of infection and then enter Switzerland within 10 days or less must go into quarantine. You can check the list of areas on [www.bag.admin.ch/entry](http://www.bag.admin.ch/entry). The list is regularly being updated.



## 2. Entering Switzerland from a country with an increased risk of infection:



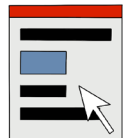
Upon arrival, go immediately to your home or to an other suitable accommodation and stay in quarantine for 10 days without going outside. If you enter Switzerland via a country or area that does not have an increased risk of infection, the cantonal authority may deduct the time spent in that country or area from the period that must be spent in quarantine.

## 3. Report to the government within two days:



Within two days upon arrival report to the cantonal authority responsible using this online tool:

[www.be.ch/quarantine](http://www.be.ch/quarantine). Anyone who does not report to the authorities is committing an offence under the Epidemicis Act and will be prosecuted.



## 4. Stay in quarantine for 10 days:



After filling out the online tool, you will be contacted by our Contact Tracers. Follow their instructions. You must stay at home or in the same suitable accomodation without going outside. Anyone who fails to comply with quarantine requirements is committing an offence and will be prosecuted.
